Judges 4-5

- Be led by the Spirit
 - As you examine your spiritual walk with Christ, are you spending enough time in His presence to be able to call Him “friend”?
 - Are you able to recognize through Scripture when He is speaking to you?
 - Do your words and actions represent who Jesus is?
- Recognize our enemies
 - Scripture is the best place to discover those enemies/prone to’s in your life. This year, has the Lord revealed any of these to you through His Word?
 - Look over the identity statements. Which ones do you need to make a permanent part of your life?
 - **Most of the time, if you embrace your identity in Christ, the enemies will gradually leave because there will be no room for them to exist!**
- Arise, do the thing God is asking
 - Think back over this Bible Study year. As a result of what you have heard and learned, is there something God is asking you to do: Change your perspective, identify your false beliefs and start living your identity, change a behavior, start pursuing your spiritual growth more fervently, etc.? What is it?
 - What is holding you back from starting? If you started, what has stalled you?
- Follow God’s lead into battle
 - Is there a confrontation of the enemy that you are avoiding? What is it?
 - What is holding you back from this confrontation?
 - **Remember: God’s people with God’s power, even with inferior weapons, can destroy the enemy!**
- Invite warriors to battle alongside of us
 - Give some practical ways to cultivate friendships with godly women.
 - Do you have godly people in your life that help you battle sin/prone to’s?
 - If you don’t have these relationships (especially with women), what has prevented you from developing them?
- Utterly destroy our enemies
 - One of the things God does is he uses the “everyday” things and events of life to help you slay the enemy (Jael, who set up the tent, used her skill in driving a tent peg to slay Sisera).
 - What are everyday things in your life that can be used to slay your enemies (daily time with the Lord, worship music in the background, etc.).
 - Are there things that need to become “everyday” so that you can slay the enemy? What are they?
