The Bleeding Woman  
Mark 5:25-34

- The bleeding woman **heard about Jesus and placed herself where He was.**
  - **As you think about your walk with Christ, do you consistently come into His presence just to be with Him?**
  - **Several of you discuss what consistently entering into God's presence looks like for you.**
- The bleeding woman also did not allow the heavy crowd to stop her.
  - Share if there are any obstacles in your life that keep you from Jesus' presence.
  - What does it take personally, to say "no" to the obstacles?
- What does a life that is "all in" look like?
  - As you evaluate your walk with Christ, would you say that your life is characterized as someone who is "all in"?
  - How does that play out daily?
- Faith should never be stagnant but always moving. To keep faith moving, always know where God is working and then join Him.
  - How do you find out where God is working in your life?
  - How do you find out where God is working in the world?
  - How do you know where to join Him?
- Are you a "maybe God will" or a "probably God won't" person?
  - Why is this your default setting?
  - How can you change your default setting?
- Faith must always respond. The million dollar question is, "How does my faith respond on a daily basis?"
  - How does your faith learn to respond in a bold trust in Jesus Christ no matter the circumstances?
  - How does your faith learn to respond in awe and wonder because you are in a relationship with the God of the universe?
  - How does your faith learn to respond in freedom and peace because you are no longer who you used to be?
